

By car:

Loddington in Leicestershire is situated approximately five miles west of Uppingham off the main A47 Peterborough to Leicester road, 25 minutes west of the A1 Junction at Wansford. It is signposted on the A47 at the turn-off to East Norton.

On entering the village, turn right at the 'T' junction. Manor Farm (Visitor Centre) is on the left just before the first left hand bend.

We now have four car charging points at the Allerton Project Visitor Centre. Payment can be made by contactless at each device.

By train:

There is a half hourly train service from St. Pancras Station to Market Harborough (one hour) on the Midland Main Line, then 20 minutes by car/taxi;

Or an hourly service on Cross Country Trains between Birmingham New Street and Stansted Airport which stops at Oakham, then 10 minutes by car/taxi to Loddington. This connects with the GNER service from London to Edinburgh on the East Coast line at Peterborough.
